YOUTH DEVELOPMENT CATEGORY

Criteria

A. Database (5%)

- i) Mosque maintains records of its youths. The database is updated and easy to use.

B. Recruitment & Training (20%)

- i) Avail application membership form at mosque's office, website, notice board etc..
- ii) Development programs for "in-mosque youths" ie. Members of the mosque youth outfit and students of mosque madrasah.
- iii) Clear leadership skills development program for leaders/activists of the mosque youth outfit
- iv) Has a clear youth development plan

C. Programmes (25%)

- i) Has outreach programs to "out-of-mosque youths" including mosque-school partnership
- ii) At least one signature program that benefit youths throughout Singapore
- iii) Collaborates with external agencies (Muslim/Non-Muslim) to organize programmes for youths
- iv) Orientation program for new youth members
- v) Organize one activity by "in-mosque-youths" for "out-of-mosque" youths and youth at large

D. Youth Structure (25%)

- i) Mosque has a youth development officer to manage its youths and coordinate youth activities and programmes
- ii) Youth development is an agenda in MMB meetings
- iii) Mosque has designated youth area – 'lepak' area
- iv) Mosque has designated youth area – activity centre

- v) Youth leader is represented in MMB ie. Appointed Board member
- vi) Existence of organizational structure of mosque youth outfit
- vii) Membership size of at least 100
- viii) Has a youth reporting structure at the mosque

E. Policy/Guidelines for Youths (10%)

- i) Has budget allocation for the programmes for and organised by the youths.
- ii) Has youths' code of conduct made known.

F. Recognition & Rewards/Awards (15%)

- i) Mosque creates a sense of belonging/affiliation to the mosque for the youths.
- ii) Mosque has incentive schemes/ motivation for the youths to continue serving at the mosque.
- iii) Mosque has a scheme to recognize the service of its youths.
